New Website Coming! Should be live by mid feb. Fixes existing calendar issue, modernizes, allows online bookings,

New site from Marketing budget - \$1000

Current Wix Price - \$43/month = ~\$500/year

New Hosting \$75 for 4 years, \$10/month after that.

New Website Saves ~\$1000 over 4 years, and \$360/year after that.

Sharper Marina Management Software will be live by March

Member Login page on new website to manage invoices, contracts, see payment history. Much easier to create occupancy and sales reports on the office side as well.

Early estimates should save office 300-400 hours/year

We already have almost 2 dozen on the waitlist for MYCF (Minnesota Yacht Club Festival)

LH Sewer Credit - \$2,197.85 for last winter - to be split between LH residents

\$2,661.15 for last summer to the club

We would like to put counters on the fuel dock tank and upper harbor tank so we can file for both of them.
